NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$28 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check (this is the current amount charged for return checks in the city of Huntsville).
- Dog **must** be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Dogs may be registered online at www.nadac.com.

This trial will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded from the NADAC web site at www.nadac.com. Exhibitors may request a written copy of the current Exhibitor Handbook by submitting a request to NADAC, PO Box 1206, Colbert, OK 74733

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

- This event will be held on packed earth in an indoor arena (95' x 100'). There is a concrete floor indoors for crating. The arena has fans and heaters.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at ANY time. Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers.
- There will be no familiarization period. A small warm-up area with a single practice jump and a set of 6 weave poles will be provided. No other equipment or training devices will be allowed on the show grounds from Friday 1:00 pm to Sunday 7 pm.
- Concessions will be available at the trial site for lunch.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the trial.
- Entries will not be accepted or canceled following the closing date. EXCEPTION: Previously accepted entries may be altered only for the purpose of advancement to a higher class if notification is received by April 19, 2010.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal.

- The Trial Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. Any competitor who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Total entry fee less \$5 for each day entered will be refunded for bitches coming into season after the closing date. A veterinarian's statement is required prior to the start of judging on Saturday.
- All dogs entered will receive a "thanks for coming to play with us" toy. Placements (1st – 4th) will receive a ribbon. Placements will not be awarded in Chances, as it is a pass/fail class. All Qualifiers will receive a rosette. Dogs completing a title may receive a NACC titling ribbon.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Competitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run and MUST contact the gate steward prior to the start of the class with any request to run out of order for Regular, Chances and Jumpers classes.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep the trial site and hotels clean.
- Entries sent by overnight mail MUST be sent with a signature waiver. No one will be available to sign for the package and it will be sent back to you undelivered if the waiver is not signed.

Proficient/Skilled Categories:

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. In the Skilled Category, dogs **must** jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4"). Dogs entered in the Regular Class of the Skilled Category may incur 5 or fewer faults (course/time) and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round. In the Proficient category a qualifying round must be clean with no course faults or time faults.

Non-Jumping classes – Veteran or Disabled Handler:

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the NADAC Agility list and set your settings to "no mail." You'll be able to view trial results and find discrepancies (if any) without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Directions to the Trial Site

The Alabama A&M University Agribition Center is located at 4925 Moores Mill Road, Huntsville, AL 35811.

From I-65: Take Exit 340, which is the I-565 exit to Huntsville. Continue on I-565 as it goes through Huntsville. On the eastern side of Huntsville, I-565 will turn into US Hwy 72 East. At the bottom of the hill, there is a stop light at Moores Mill Road. Turn north (left). The arena is approximately 3/4 of a mile on your left.

From the East on US Highway 72: Travel towards Huntsville. At the intersection of US Hwy 72 and Moores Mill Road, turn north (right). The arena is approximately 3/4 of a mile on your left.

RV Hook-ups and Stall Rentals

There are 14 RV hook-ups with limited services (electricity and water only). The cost is \$15 per day. Reservations must be made directly with the Facility Manager at 256-859-5896.

There are several outdoor stalls available for rental at \$10 per day. The area is covered and has electrical outlets and ceiling fans.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the forementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
